

Readers Theatre Tuck Everlasting

Readers' theater is an opportunity to bring stories to life in a creative and imaginative way.

1. Each assigned team converts assigned chapters into typed scripts. Each member must read/perform dramatically.
2. Team will incorporate at least 1 background image using ppt. (related to setting of assigned readings)
3. Must use props related to assigned reading.
4. Prior to performance: Briefly summarize for the audience the characters, plot, setting, conflicts of assigned reading.
5. Students can incorporate music, posters or costumes (this is optional)

Grading:

- How well do students dramatize and read assigned chapters?
- Props, costumes, background images.
- How well did students organize their presentation? Is it apparent that students rehearsed and planned presentation effectively? (Time limit 10 minutes.)
- Each student must type out his or her assigned portion of the reading.
- Each student must speak with good volume and clarity. - Remember to do well you must rehearse, read your part aloud in a mirror or in front of friends and family.
